

Seymour and Shepparton

New timetables and extra services will be introduced from Sunday 31 March 2019.



Highlights

- 2 new weekday train services introduced.
- Changes will be made to the arrival and departure times of services to reduce delays.



Weekday train services

- A new train from Southern Cross Station to Shepparton departing at 5:53am. This will be an extension of an existing Seymour service.
- A new train with café bar facilities from Shepparton to Southern Cross Station departing at 9:35am stopping all stations except Tallarook, Heathcote Junction and Donnybrook.
- A new weekday peak service from Melbourne to Seymour, departing Southern Cross Station at 4:02 pm. Stopping all stations except Tallarook and Heathcote Junction.



Train time changes

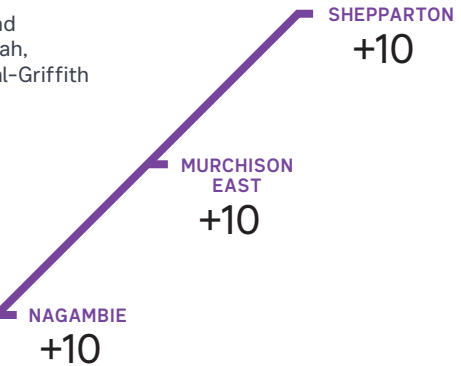
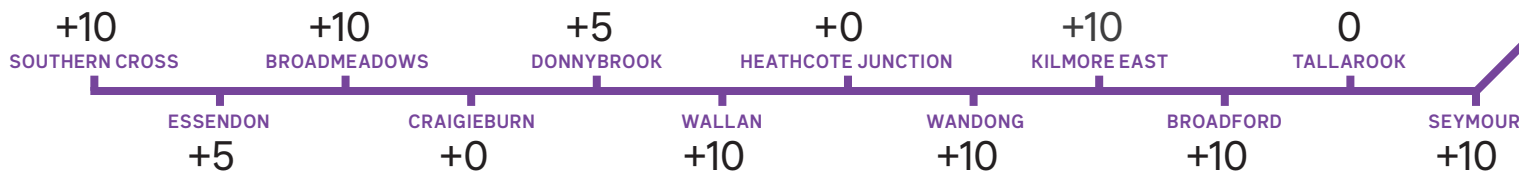
- Some Seymour train journey times will increase by up to three minutes and Shepparton train journey times will increase by up to five minutes to reflect actual running times, incorporating permanent speed restrictions on the line.
- A weekday, Saturday and Sunday service on the Seymour line will now be scheduled to run as sprinter trains, reducing journey times by 5-7 minutes on those services.



Coach services

- The 6:50am weekday coach from Tocumwal to Shepparton will depart at 6:30am, connecting with the retimed 10:14am train from Seymour to Southern Cross Station.
- The 7:55am coach from Seymour to Shepparton will no longer run because of the new train service.
- Coach route timetables to and from Albury-Wodonga, Barmah, Alexandra, Cobram-Tocumwal-Griffith and Echuca-Moama will be reissued to reflect changes to connecting trains.
