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Train Replacement Coach Stops

All Coach operators and drivers should be aware that the V/Line train replacement stopping locations are identified by purple PTV signage with the wording 'Train Replacement Coach Stop' as pictured below.

This document identifies where each train replacement coach stop is located on the Eastern corridor between Bairnsdale and Southern Cross station and how to access these locations.

If you notice any replacement signage damaged, please report to your company Operations Manager who can notify V/Line.

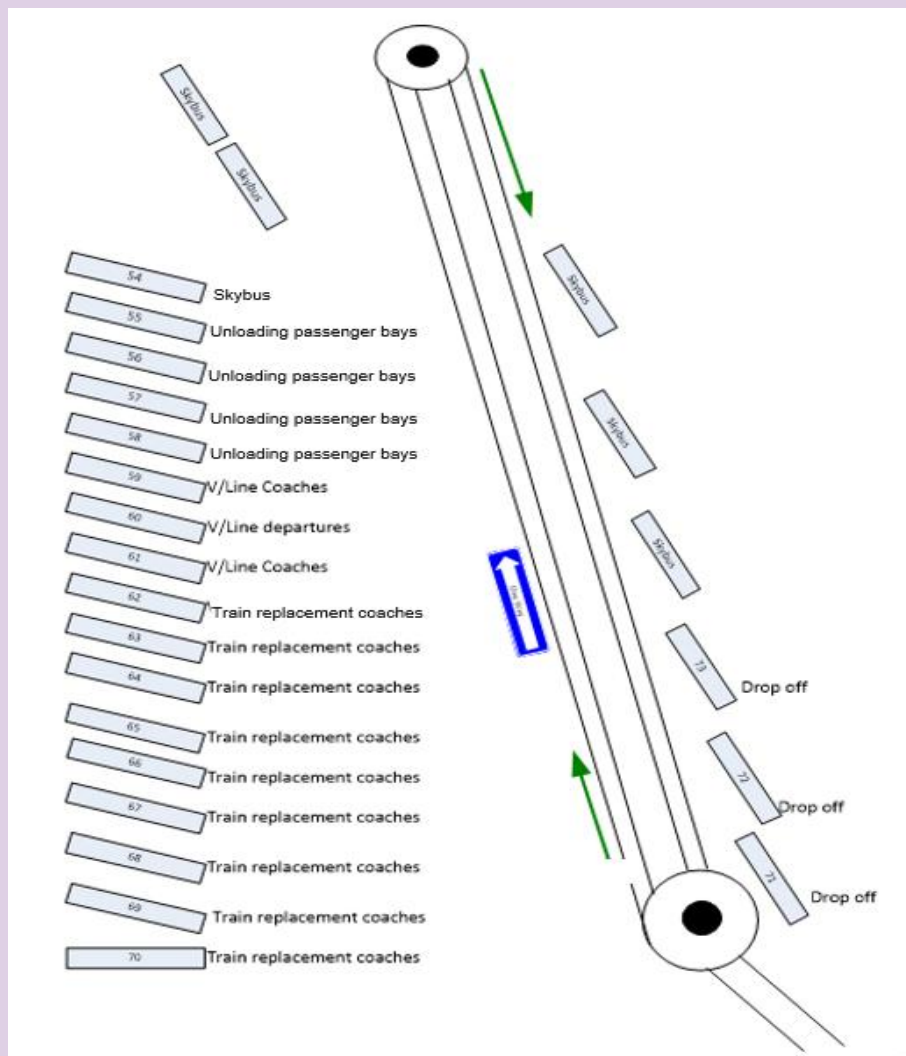

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Train Replacement Coach Drivers Operating Information

At Southern Cross Station

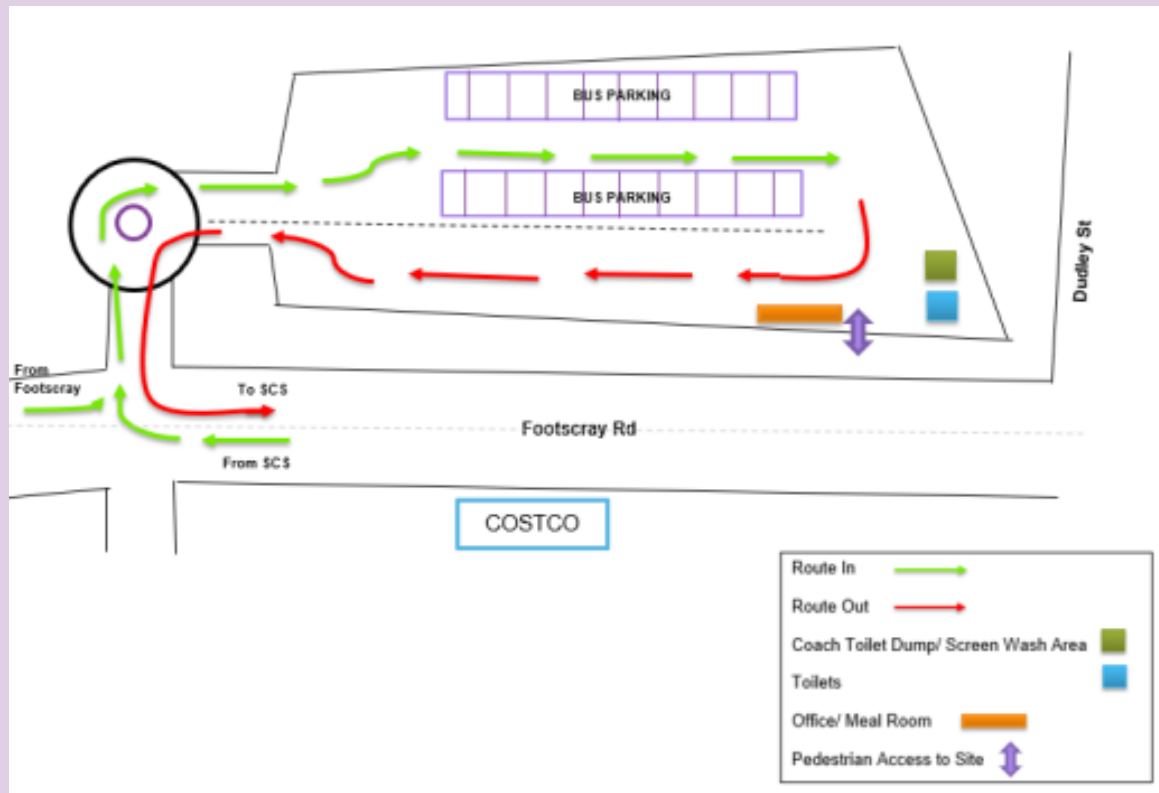
- When entering the coach terminal area, keep left at the roundabout, and use bays 62 – 70 or as otherwise directed for service departures. Unloading passenger bays are 55 – 58 with 71 & 72 used as overflow unloading bays.
- On arrival in the coach terminal, drivers are to report to station staff who will provide the run details. If there are no staff present, please stay near your coach so staff can find you.
- When you are ready to leave the loading bay, switch on your hazard lamps, check for traffic, and reverse out. Give way to through coaches.
- When reversing watch out for concrete pillars



At City Layover Site- Footscray Road

VLine have a site to layover coaches and feed into the Terminal.

VLine will provide notification as to whether this facility will be open and available to utilise.



Conditions of Travel

Ticketing

- Drivers are not involved in issuing or checking V/Line tickets.
- Under no circumstances should drivers accept cash from passengers
- Drivers may assist in checking tickets to understand where set downs are required.

Announcements

To ensure passengers clearly understand the stopping conditions of the service they have boarded, coach drivers will be required to make a number of announcements, including:

- The announcement of stopping locations **prior** to leaving the originating station and at each station. Drivers must announce that seat belts must be worn.
- On arrival at the destination station remind passengers to take their personal belongings with them before leaving the coach.

VLine have coach driver announcement guides produced for replacement services. These are available from your ticket supplier PMG.

Food & Drink on coaches

- Alcohol is not permitted in the passenger area of the coaches under any circumstance.
- Cold packaged food and drinks with a screw top lid may be brought on and consumed on board the coach.
- No hot/ odorous food or hot/ uncapped drinks may be brought on and consumed on board the coach.

Luggage and loading

- At terminal stations, drivers must remain with their coach whilst loading. Preferably, drivers should be at the door to assist passengers boarding.
- Passengers are required to manage their own luggage. Please assist as appropriate in loading luggage into the luggage compartment.

The luggage allowance on a Train Replacement Coach service is 32kg per customer (with no one item weighing more than 16kg, as well as one piece of hand luggage). Main luggage must be stored in the luggage compartment underneath the coach.

Hand luggage is permitted with the dimensions no greater than:

Length 40cm x Width 35cm x Height 15cm

- Bicycles can be carried on replacement coaches subject to space in the luggage area and will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Customers must load and unload their bicycle onto the coach and they are carried at the owner's risk
- Prams/ children's car seats/ wheelchairs and small items of sporting and camping equipment will be treated as one piece of luggage.
- Surfboards/ surf skis/similar items are not permitted and will not be carried as luggage.

Animals

- Assistance animals (Guide dogs / Guide dogs in training/ hearing guide dogs and animals identified with an Animal Assistance Pass) are permitted on these services.
- No other animals including domestic pets are permitted to travel in the coach or the luggage compartment underneath the coach.
- For an unplanned replacement service, drivers can contact IOC comms (9619 5073) for support and clarification if required.

Passenger capacity

When loading large numbers of passengers, keep track of numbers boarding, so that you don't have to take people off once they have boarded. If you are loaded to capacity, or close to and think you may not be able to pick up more passengers at subsequent stops, you must advise the IOC (9619 5073 or 9619 5927 – not for public) at the earliest opportunity so alternative arrangements can be made for the passengers left behind.

Accessibility

To travel on V/Line services with a mobility aid or wheelchair, it must:

- Fit within an allocated space of 1300mm (length) and 800mm (width)
- Be no more than 750mm wide at a height of 300mm above the ground to fit between the wheel axles of a coach
- Have a total combined weight of less than 300kg, including the mobility aid, its user and any attendant
- Have anchor points for travel on a V/Line coach which will be used to secure the mobility aid to ensure safety.

Mobility aids that exceed these standards may not be able to be accommodated

If a passenger requires wheelchair access and your coach does not have provision for it:

- At staffed stations – refer to station staff who will arrange alternative transport.
- At unstaffed station – advise the IOC (9619 5073) who will arrange alternative transport.

If you have vision impaired or less mobile passengers, who require assistance at Southern Cross, advise the IOC Comms (9619 5073 or 9619 5927) so that V/Line Customer Service personnel can meet your coach on arrival.

Standees

On all services, all passengers must be seated. If you encounter an overload situation, contact the IOC (9619 5073) immediately so alternative arrangements can be made.

Late running

During times of late running or disruption to the schedule of the road coach, you will need to inform your customers and advise any alternative arrangements. After your announcement, gather information about customers connecting to other rail, air or road services and advise the IOC (9619 5073). Should you require any guidance on delivering these announcements, please refer to our coach driver announcement guide.

Train Replacement Coach Presentation

Clean and Presentable Manner

Coaches are to have:

- Clean exteriors, clean paintwork, and windows
- Clean interiors, floors, seats, and windows

Drivers are requested to clean the interior of the coach prior to commencing each trip and ensure the floors, seats and windows are clean and that toilets are clean and functioning properly.

Driver Presentation

Drivers must wear their company uniform, be well groomed, neat and clean. Males should be clean shaven or with beard / moustache neatly trimmed.

Radios & TV

Under no circumstances are radios or television sets to be turned on during trips. There is no radio or TV on the train service and V/Line policy deems this needs to remain the same on coach services. Similarly, passengers should not allow the noise from their personal devices to interfere with the comfort of others.

Coach contact / communication – mobile phones

Communication with the driver at all times is essential. Ensure your mobile phone is switched on, charged and with you at all times. Be aware of and obey the law regarding the use of mobile phones. A hands free device is essential. Remember that there are up to 48 witnesses to any breach of the law. V/Line take non-compliance with the law very seriously.

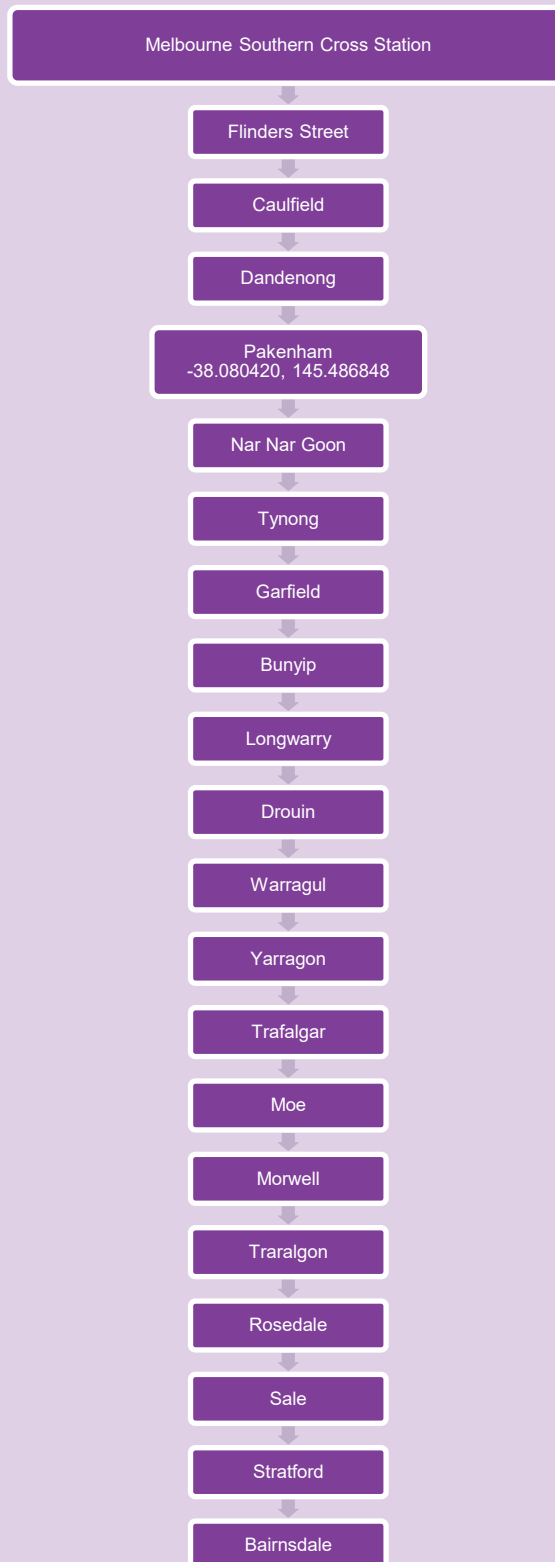
Lost Property

At the end of each trip drivers are required to inspect the coach thoroughly for any items that may have been left behind. Please hand any lost property to station staff at the nearest staffed station to where the passenger alighted.

V/Line Identification

All Train Replacement Coaches must display purple 'V/Line Service' stickers attached to the front windscreen or 'V/Line Service' displayed on the electronic passenger display. For planned rail replacement, the run number (i.e. "BXG 1") must be displayed in the windscreen as well as on the passenger side window beside the door. If the coach has a dark tint, please endeavour to make the text as bold as possible.
